UNOPPOSED MOTION TO EXTEND TIME
TO FILE BRIEF ON THE MERITS

TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS:

Pursuant to Rule 10.5(b) and Rule 55.7 of the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure, Respondent files this motion and asks for a thirty (30) day extension of time by which to file his brief on the merits. This is the first request for an extension of time for Respondent’s brief. The Court previously granted Petitioner two extensions of time to file her merits brief, and as a result Respondent’s merits brief is currently due on March 8, 2018. Granting this motion would make the Respondent’s brief due on Monday, April 9, 2018.

The extension sought is necessary to allow Respondent’s appellate counsel, Kurt Kuhn, adequate time to properly prepare the brief. Mr. Kuhn has had several

other matters and briefs that have and continue to impede Mr. Kuhn's ability to finish the brief by the current deadline.

The motion is unopposed. Neither the Court nor any party will be prejudiced by the granting of this motion. This extension is not sought for the purposes of delay, but to allow Respondent's counsel adequate time to fully brief the issues for the Court.

For these reasons, Respondent asks for an additional thirty (30) days to file his brief on the merits, extending the time until April 9, 2018.
