JUDGMENT

THE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS, having heard this cause on petition for review from the Court of Appeals for the Third District, and having considered the appellate record, briefs, and counsels' arguments, concludes that the court of appeals' judgment should be affirmed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, in accordance with the Court's opinion, that:

- 1) The court of appeals' judgment is affirmed; and
- 2) Petitioner shall pay, and respondent shall receive, costs incurred in this Court and in the court of appeals.
