Respondent/s shall file their response brief **July 29, 2013**.


Petitioner/s shall file any reply brief **August 6, 2013**.

PLEASE NOTE pursuant to Misc. Docket No. 11-9152 - Electronic-Filing Rules, Attorneys **must e-file** all documents (except documents submitted under seal) through Texas.gov. Persons not represented by an attorney may e-file documents, but e-filing is not

required. Four paper copies of the requested brief on the merits must be filed within three business days after the supplemental brief is e-filed. The paper courtesy copies must be the printed version of the file-stamped e-filed supplemental brief and must comply with Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure 9. You may file up to midnight on the due date.
