TO THE HONORABLE SUPREME COURT OF TEXAS:

The State of Texas as *Amicus Curiae* requests a two-week extension of time to file its brief of *Amicus Curiae* pursuant to Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure 53.7(f) and 10.5(b).

**I.**
